### Getting Here

VT Communications Head Office is situated on the south bank of the River Thames in Southwark.

### By boat

A ferry service runs from Embankment or Festival Pier to Bankside.

### By Underground

Southwark (Jubilee Line), London Bridge (Northern and Jubilee Line), Waterloo (Northern, Jubilee and Bakerloo Line), Blackfriars (District and Circle Lines) are the closest underground stations both of which are approximately ten minutes walk away.

### **By bus**

A number of buses service the area, including:

**RV1** / Runs between the Tower of London, Tate Modern and Covent Garden.

**45** / Streatham Hill to King's Cross via Holborn Circus stopping on Blackfriars Bridge Road.

**63** / Crystal Palace to King's Cross via Farringdon Road stopping on Blackfriars Bridge Road.

**100** / Elephant and castle to Shadwell stopping on Blackfriars Bridge Road.

**381** / Peckham to Waterloo stopping on Southwark Street.

**344** / Clapham Junction to Liverpool Street Station stopping on Southwark Bridge Road.

### **By train**

Thameslink links between Bedford and Brighton stop at Blackfriars and London Bridge stations. London Bridge also carries a service to South East London and Kent. Waterloo station carries a service to the Southwest.

### **Journey Planner**

### **By taxi or Dial-a-Ride**

If arriving by taxi or Dial-a-Ride please ask the driver to take you to the West Entrance on Holland Street.

### **By car**

Public transport is the easiest way of reaching the VT Communications Head Quarters as parking is severely restricted in the surrounding streets.

### **By bike**

There is a bicycle shelter at outside the building.

### **By foot**

From Waterloo Road, head north until you get to the IMAX round about, turn east into Stamford Road. Keep walking, after 5 minutes you will enter Southwark Street. For further directions by foot visit <http://www.walkit.com/london/>.
